This team provides services to high-risk and high-needs adolescents (aged 12 to 18) within local out-of-home residential settings, in the community and within youth justice sites, including London probation.

Qualifications:

- candidate must hold a Master's degree in psychology, social work, or a related discipline; preference given to those applicants with relevant clinical experience
- preferred candidates are registered (or qualify to become registered in near future) with the College of Social Workers or the College of Registered Psychotherapists of Ontario (CRPO) or another accredited professional regulating body
- competencies in cognitive behavioural therapy and dialectical behavioural therapy are an asset, along with skill in providing individual, family and group counselling services
- ability to develop treatment interventions within residential and community settings
- experience in providing counselling services to high-risk youth identified as having criminal involvement, trauma histories, addiction issues and inappropriate sexual behaviour
